WHAT DOES THE WORD LIOCO MEAN?

it is a fusion of our last names li-cklider + oco-nnor = lioco.

WHAT IS LIOCO'S FOCUS?

- + gently treated, naturally-fermented chardonnay & pinot noir from marquis vineyard sites.
- + an "heirloom" californian blend of old-vine carignan, petite sirah, & grenache.
- + a pinot blanc with pedigree too fine to pass up.

WHAT IS LIOCO'S CORE BELIEF?

careful vineyard selection, strident farming, and a restrained winemaking approach will produce compelling wine.

WHAT IS LIOCO'S PHILOSOPHY?

- + great wine is grown, not made.
- + balance > power.
- + over-deliver for the price point.

WHAT IS LIOCO'S CREDO?

"wine from the ground up."

WHAT DISTINGUISHES LIOCO FROM OTHER WINERIES?

matt & kevin's global perspective. we take our inspiration not so much from neighboring wineries, but rather from the great domains of europe—whose wines we were drinking, discussing, & selling long before lioco was born.
