two cooler sites straddling the russian river at confluence of alexander valley, dry creek, and russian river valley appellations. ancient alluvial soils composed of sand and gravel, with some volcanic rock. contrast of morning fog, mid-day sunshine, and afternoon sea breezes produces comp ex flavors and crisp acidity.
