contact. bottled without fining or  
filtration. 468 cases produced.

**SITE**

designated block of old vines on flank of russian river. lies at  
confluence of alexander valley, chalk hill, and russian river valley  
appellations. ancient alluvial soils composed of sand and gravel,  
with some volcanic-rock. contrast of morning fog, mid-day sunshine,  
and afternoon sea breezes produces complex flavors and crisp acidity.
