VINIFICATION

9 tons hand-harvested between Aug 31st and Sept 14th. Berries were destemmed and gently crushed before going to press. All lots fermented on wild yeasts and aged seperately for 10 months in 600L neutral oak puncheons, before being racked off the lees to steel for an additional 6 months. A slow malolactic fermentation completed. Cross-flow filtered prior to bottling.

SITE

This wine is made from a selection of our favorite Russian River Valley vineyards. All sites are situated 10-15 miles from the coast, on gravelly loam and sandstone soils planted to Clone 4, Dijon 95 + 96, and Curtis clone. This growing region is distinguished by its complex relationship with the cold Pacific Ocean, omnipresent fog, ancient redwoods, and the Russian River itself.
