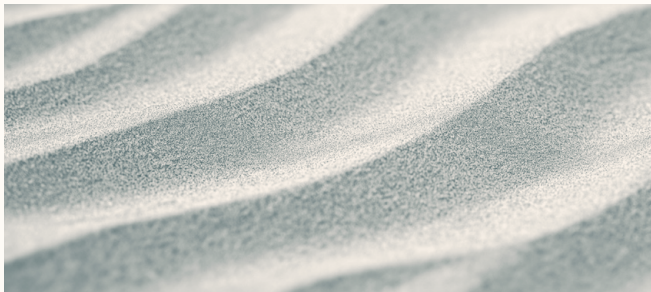

VINIFICATION

1.77 T of pristine Grüner Veltliner was hand-picked on Sept 17th. The fruit was crushed and sent directly-to- press. The juice was intentionally oxidized and cold fermented on wild yeasts in stainless steel barrels + one neutral puncheon. Aged sur- lees for 5-months. Bottled without fining or filtration.

SITE

Kick-on Ranch is 14-miles from the Pacific Ocean in the East/West running Los Alamos Valley. Cold ocean breezes ensure slow and even ripening. Soils are grey sandy loam, low in nutrients, and produce lower yielding vines. Grüner material is Davis Clone 1 and was grafted in 2012 onto some Pinot Gris vines (planted in 2000 on 101-14 rootstock). Our section of the vineyard is farmed by Graham Tatomer.
